Kohler Alignment for Nikon

- 1. Choose 20X, it should state PH1 on the objective wall.
- 2. Push the polarizing filter on top out toward the right
- 3. Focus on the cells
- 4. Switch the phase filter to A, bright field
- 5. Screw to Close down the top aperture
- 6. Close down the bottom diaphragm to reduce the light intensity
- 7. Adjust the condenser knob up and down until a clear hexagon edge can be observed
- 8. Adjust the two screw knobs to center the aperture
- 9. Open the top aperture and the bottom diaphragm to full range
- 10. Focus on the cells again, the images should be clear
- 11. If needed, switch to 40X or 100X,
- 12. Switch the phase filter to DIC
- 13. Push the polarizing filter on top in toward the left
- 14. Focus
- 15. Adjust the polarizing filter by tuning the handle until the best contrast obtained
