Preparing 1% agarose gel for cell adhesion

Materials:

Agarose, PBS

Procedures:

- 1. Mix 0.1g of agarose with 10ml PBS. Disolve in hood.
- 2. Microwave the mixture for 10 or 5 second intervals until there are no visible agarose crystals. Note: keep the cap untightened during microwave.
- 3. Add 1ml of mixture to each dish. Wait 5mins for the mixture to dry out.
- 4. Add 1ml PBS to each dish to keep the gel wet.
- 5. Place the dishes in incubator.
- 6. Before imaging, detach the cells with EDTA, keep them in suspension (can keep with PBS in incubator).
